



## GUEST ROWER POLICY

The purpose of this policy is to accommodate *experienced scullers and sweep rowers, 18 and over, from out of the area* and provide them with a friendly “home away from home” while visiting the Orlando Metro area.

Guest rowers need to contact [info@orlandorowingclub.com](mailto:info@orlandorowingclub.com) in advance to arrange an initial date and time to meet at the boathouse.

An experienced rower may row once, at no charge, as a guest of Orlando Rowing Club. Should his or her schedule permit, the guest rower’s access to club equipment may be extended for a period of up to two consecutive weeks at a cost of \$25.

An ORC designee will meet the guest at the boathouse, assuring that an ORC Waiver is completed and filed, that safety and traffic rules are reviewed and log record use is explained.

The ORC designee accepts responsibility for ensuring that ORC equipment policies and procedures are followed. Should damage to equipment occur, the guest is to promptly report such in the Equipment Repair Log Book.

The ORC designee is responsible for the behavior of the guest rower.

The ORC designee may not reserve equipment for the guest rower in the Reservation System. The guest rower may only use equipment that has not been reserved. It is the responsibility of the ORC designee to determine which equipment is available for guest use.

If the *experienced rower from out of the area wants to guest row with a crew in a sweep boat*, contact ORC in advance at [info@orlandorowingclub.com](mailto:info@orlandorowingclub.com) to make arrangements.

ORC will work with an appropriate Boat Captain to place the guest rower for a one-time courtesy row.

The ORC Boat Captain will assure that an ORC Waiver will be completed and filed.

If the rower wishes to row for additional sessions and his or her schedule permits, the ORC Boat Captain will attempt to place the rower in an appropriate boat. The Guest rower may row for up to two consecutive weeks at a cost of \$25. ORC cannot guarantee a seat in a sweep boat for the guest rower.
