



ORC Takes Team Points Trophy at Giblet

ORLANDO, FL (November 21, 2009) - In this year's Head of the Giblet Regatta, ORC wrapped up the fall head race season winning the **Team All Points trophy** rowing against Edgewater masters, ROCCS and OARS. We were proud to see two women's novice eights finish within four seconds of each other, and a men's novice four race for the first time! Over 40 ORC crew members raced in 10 events earning medals in all events.

Jamie Thomas and Roseanne Latta kicked the day off by finishing 1st and 2nd in the Women's Master's 1x. Tony Scarcella completed his first head race rowing in the Men's Masters Novice 1x. And ORC scullers Brad Ingram and Jamie Thomas, and Harry and Anne Robinson rowed to 2nd and 3rd place finishes in the Mixed Master's 2x.

In the 4+ sweep boats, the ORC crew of L. Silvia, C. Rhodes, K. Broome, S. Cobb and M. Walter (cox) took 1st in the Women's Masters Open 4+. The ORC crew of D. D'Alesandro, B. Eng, M. Brink, P. Legowski, and S. Jamilla (cox) rowed to a 1st place finish in the Women's Masters Novice 4+. The Men's Masters Novice 4+ rowed to a 2nd place finish and was crewed by D. Lukasik, R. Scibicki, S. Kramer, M. Kessler, and M. Simms (cox). Completing the fours for the day, was the crew of L. Silvia, M. Tizekker, D. Lukasik, L. Reikki, and M. Simms (cox) who rowed to a 1st place finish in the Mixed Master's Open 4+.
